IN MEMORIAM Roman Jan Dwilewicz 1949 - 2016



Our dear friend and colleague Roman Jan Dwilewicz passed away after a brief illness in Missouri on July 29, 2016.

Professor Dwilewicz was born in Mragowo, Poland, on November 6, 1949. He was raised in the towns of Mragowo and Olsztyn. He enrolled at the University of Warsaw in 1966, obtaining M.Sc. and Ph.D. degrees in mathematics (summa cum laude) in 1971 and 1976, respectively, and a D.Sc. (habilitation) in mathematics in 1985.

Over the years he worked at University of Warsaw, University of Montreal, University of Regina, University of Western Ontario, Texas A&M and University of Missouri at Rolla.

Professor Dwilewicz came to the Department of Mathematics and Statistics at Missouri University of Science and Technology – then the University of Missouri at Rolla – as Associate Professor in 2001. He earned tenure at Missouri S&T in 2004 and in 2006 he was promoted to Professor of Mathematics.

In recognition of his notable contributions in scholarship, he received the 2012 Missouri University of Science and Technology Research Award.

In 2008, Roman was honoured by the President of Poland with the title of Professor of Mathematical Sciences. This prestigious title represents the apex of an academic career in Poland.

During his professional life, Professor Dwilewicz was invited to give lectures at more than 250 universities and conferences on four continents. He published over 60 research papers and books in complex and geometric analysis, analytic number theory, partial differential equations, and algebraic and differential geometry.

Professor Roman Jan Dwilewicz was recommended by Professor Časlav V. Stanojević to the Editorial Board of Mathematica Moravica (http://www.moravica.ftn.kg.ac.rs) where he served with distinction. Premature death of Professor Dwilewicz is a great loss for his colleagues at Mathematica Moravica.
